The Vic studios	Grant	£5000	To develop a strong online presence, online resources, and an integrated online booking system. By investing in each of these, Vic Studios would become a more visible, welcoming and accessible service to its target audience (mostly young people), simultaneously increasing the number of people benefiting from its services, and reducing the costs and time of administering them.
